New capacity for TeXtreme™ and TeXero™

Oxeon is investing in large scale capacity for TeXtreme™ and TeXero™. Sample volumes of both TeXtreme™ and TeXero™ have been well accepted by customers in different areas who have evaluated the tape woven fabrics and the narrow UD-tapes. Oxeon recently raised a new round of Venture Capital from among others Latour Industrier AB and are now expanding the business by investing in increased capacity.

“The great interest in our products, the lack of lightweight carbon fibre fabrics on the market and our strong owners makes us believe we are in a great position to make life easier for composite manufacturers and end users,” said Oxeon’s Chief Executive Officer, Andreas Josefsson.

TeXtreme™ and TeXero™ do not only deliver increased performance but also brings flexibility into the value chain. The unique technologies developed by Oxeon enables production of TeXtreme™ and TeXero™ from intermediate and heavy tows (12k and larger) in a wide range of areal weights. TeXtreme™ starts at $\sim 80 \text{ g/m}^2$ ($\sim 2,36 \text{ oz/yd}^2$) and TeXero™ at $\sim 40 \text{ g/m}^2$ ($\sim 1,18 \text{ oz/yd}^2$) and tape woven fabrics are produced in widths up to 1500 mm ($\sim 59''$) while the UD tapes comes in widths up to 300 mm ($\sim 12''$)

The new capacity will be in place towards the end of Q1 2007 and is being filled up quickly.
